## Order of Service

(Memorial Masses without the body of the deceased begin in front without a procession with family. Family is seated in advance.)

**Funeral Liturgy** -The family is greeted at the front entrance of the church. The Presider sprinkles Holy Water from the Baptismal Font on the casket or cremains. If casket, the white pall is placed over the casket (This may be done by family members.) The procession proceeds down the aisle and the family is escorted into their pews by the funeral director. In the case of cremation, cremated remains are carried down the aisle by designated person (no pall is placed).
